## The Boulder Concert Band

The Boulder Concert Band has a storied history, originating with the ICC Silver Cornet Band of 1870, which performed weekly concerts in the pioneering town of Boulder. In 1897, the Boulder Citizen's Band, renowned as the preeminent of its kind in Colorado, was established. Subsequently, the Boulder Municipal Band, the first to incorporate female musicians, was formed. Under the direction of Hugh McMillen, former Director of Bands at the University of Colorado, the current Boulder Concert Band was organized between 1976 and 1978. It stands as one of the most prominent adult community bands in the United States, comprising all-volunteer musicians from the Boulder, Longmont, and Denver metropolitan areas.

The Boulder Concert Band actively contributes to our community through various initiatives. Several of our musicians participate in intimate ensembles that perform at private and community events. The band also performs a repertoire encompassing both traditional and contemporary concert literature, concert band classics, and often features guest artists. Furthermore, it provides a platform for adults seeking to continue playing music beyond their high school or college years. During the summer months, the concert band offers music suitable for family gatherings within Boulder's picturesque city parks, a patriotic concert in Louisville on July 4th, and a private concert at the Frasier Meadows Retirement Community.

## Jon Borodach Music Director & Conductor, Boulder Concert Band

Jon Borodach, a multifaceted musical professional, has engaged in conducting, education, instrumental performance, and arrangement for both adult and young adult musicians. Prior to joining the Boulder Concert Band, he pursued studies under the guidance of Dr. Kenneth Singleton at the University of Northern Colorado, where he is currently completing his Doctor of Arts degree. Subsequently, as the conductor of the UNC Symphonic Band following the retirements of Dr. Singleton and Dr. Richard Mayne, Borodach has cultivated a close relationship with Dr. Wesley Broadnax, the Director of Bands at UNC. Borodach considers these three individuals to be among his most influential musical mentors and esteemed friends.



From 2011 to 2018, Borodach held the position of Principal Conductor and Music Director of the Thornton Community Band, responsible for programming captivating concerts throughout the North Metro region.

Born and raised in Southern California, Borodach served as the Director of Instrumental Music at Grossmont High School in La Mesa, San Diego County. Under his leadership, the Grossmont ensembles consistently achieved Superior ratings at regional music festivals and competitions. Furthermore, Borodach orchestrated concert tours to Washington D.C., Philadelphia, New York, and San Francisco, resulting in scholarships for graduates to pursue music education at esteemed universities in Texas, Nebraska, Arizona, UCLA, and several California State universities.

Between 2001 and 2004, Borodach held the position of Associate Conductor with the San Diego Wind Ensemble, a group of freelance professional musicians. Additionally, he has served as an adjudicator, clinician, and Master Teacher for music education students.

Mr. Borodach possesses extensive musical theater experience as a conductor and pit musician in the San Diego region. He holds Bachelor and Master of Music degrees from San Diego State University.

Mr. Borodach is dedicated to performing the highest-quality works in the wind band repertoire. He advocates for new music, performing compositions by emerging composers and commissioning new works by esteemed composers such as David Holsinger, David Maslanka, and Donald Grantham. Mr. Borodach also collaborates with adult musicians who assemble solely for the purpose of playing music and enjoying the shared experience of artistry, camaraderie, and friendship. We eagerly anticipate another exceptional year of creating music together!



## A National Award-Winning Band

For the fifth straight year, the Boulder Concert Band, a 70-piece symphonic wind ensemble, has been named a finalist in the American Prize competition in the Band/Wind Ensemble Performance–Community Division, 2024. The American Prize celebrates American excellence in the arts. We earned first place in 2020, and third in 2021.

This year, we submitted “*Homage: Three Tapestries*” by David R. Holsinger: “*Tapestry One (allegro)*”, “*Tapestry Two (adagio moderato)*”, “*Tapestry Three (allegro vivo)*” from our April 15, 2023 concert, under the direction of Dr. Kenneth Singleton.

We are in excellent company with other outstanding finalist ensembles from across the United States.

# Meet Our Composers!

## Tory Markiewicz

An active percussionist that specializes in Timpani, I have performed at prestigious venues like Carnegie Hall in New York City and I currently perform with Boulder Concert Band and Thornton Concert Band.

Previously I performed with Longmont Concert Band, Northglenn Performance Theatre and Drum Corps International. I hold Degrees from the School of Music, University of Wyoming, and the Glenn Korff School of Music, University of Nebraska-Lincoln. While in College, I studied with Dr. Steve Barnhart, Dr. John

Lane, and Dr. Dave Hall. I grew up in the Disability Community and advocate for individuals with Down Syndrome and their families, raising awareness, because of a family member. I currently Coach for Special Olympics for the Longmont Dolphins Swim Team.



I am delighted for making the debut of “North by Northwest” 3rd movement for Boulder Concert Band. At Nebraska I took a film and analysis doctoral class of Bernard Herrmann (1911-1975). During the class we analyzed many Alfred Hitchcock (1899-1980) films; the films I focused on were “Psycho” 1960, “Vertigo” 1958, and “North by Northwest” 1959, for my paper and presentation. I gained access to Herrmann’s hand written scores for the 3 films and arranged the music into 3 movements from Symphony Orchestra to Symphonic Band. I arranged all the 3 movements in a semester at Nebraska and presented my score to Dr. Jon Borodach. After I made some revisions, I am pleased to present my arrangements to Boulder Concert Band.

## Mike Taylor

My music education degree was earned from Oklahoma State University in 1972. A four decade music instruction career in Oklahoma followed. I was privileged to work with some truly outstanding public school band programs — bands that exist on a high national level.

After retiring and moving to Colorado, I had time to start playing my clarinet again and ultimately joined the Boulder Concert Band. Later the Firefly Winds quintet invited me to join their group. Both groups are wonderful outlets for satisfaction of my playing endeavors.

I am always searching for great new music and happened upon Ola Gjeilo's beautiful composition of The Lake Isle. My research on the music informed me that Mr. Gjeilo's composition is based on the poem "The Lake Isle of Innisfree" by William Butler Yeats. I found great inspiration from the poem and Mr. Gjeilo's musical interpretation which was my motivation for arranging this piece.

*I will arise and go now, go to Innisfree,  
And a small cabin build there, of clay and wattles made,  
Nine bean rows will I have there, a hive for the honey bee,  
And live alone in the bee loud glade.*

*I will arise and go now, for always night and day  
I hear lake water lapping with low sounds by the shore;  
While I stand on the roadway, or on the pavements grey,  
I hear it in the deep heart's core.*

## **Sheri A. VandeRiet**

I was born into music. I started singing as soon as I could talk, began piano lessons at age 7, and started playing the saxophone at age 11. My family and I sang together from early on. Our style was reminiscent of the Carter Family back in the day.

I was active in band and choir throughout middle school and high school. I studied music education at the University of Wisconsin at Eau Claire (UWEC), earning a custom, five-year Bachelor of Music Education degree (K-12 Vocal & Instrumental), majoring in both saxophone and voice with an overlapping piano minor.



I composed “Psalm of Praise” for mixed choir while in high school, and the varsity choir might have performed it in a concert (my Mom remembers this, but I don’t). While in the Women’s Glee Club at UWEC, I composed “Alleluias” for treble chorus, and our choir read through it but never performed it in concert.

After university, I continued to be active in various musical endeavors while I raised my three sons and then welcomed eight grandchildren. I have been involved in music in one way or another for my entire adult life: composer and arranger, church choir director and pianist, school choir accompanist, parent volunteer in music classes, equipment driver for Centaurus High School Drum Line, member of church worship band, member of Boulder Concert Band, member and then leader of the Boulder Big Band, even a beginning band teacher for one year in Boulder Valley Schools.

In 2015, as a member of the Boulder Concert Band, I combined “Psalm of Praise” and “Alleluias” into “Psalm & Alleluias for Concert Band,” which we performed in 2018 under the direction of Maestro Silas Nathaniel Huff.

In 2025, I reinstated the treble chorus into “Psalm and Alleluias” and invited SAFONIA to join us. I am grateful Jon Borodach for agreeing to let the band play my work, and to my daughter-in-law, Laura VandeRiet, SAFONIA board member, and to SAFONIA director Christa Fredrickson, for collaborating with the Boulder Concert Band!

## Making Music for Almost 150 Years!

- 1876 The “ICC Silver Cornet Band” was shown in a photograph taken by the Daily Camera of eight musicians on a wagon drawn by two oxen.
- 1898 The name “Boulder Citizen’s Band” was first used.
- 1899–1918 The band was directed by Bill Swartz.
- 1918–1922 The band was directed by George Oles.
- 1922–1927 The band was directed by Eliseo Jacoe, an Italian trained conductor. This was the first conductor of record with training.
- 1928–1933 Horace Jones was the director.
- 1933–1935 George Oles returned as director.
- 1936–1956 Hugh McMillen, Professor of Music at C.U. Boulder, conducted the band. Adults were paid \$2 per concert, university students 50¢, and high school students 25¢.
- 1939 The name was changed to “The Boulder Band.”
- 1956 The band was discontinued due to “unruly” audiences and lack of financial support.
- 1978–1986 The “Boulder Concert Band” was reorganized by Hugh McMillen with Charles Kassinger as Associate Conductor. During these years the band gave four concerts October to May, and four concerts in the summer. The name has remained unchanged since 1978, and band members receive no compensation, but pay dues to participate.
- 1986–1991 Richard Culver became the conductor.
- 1992–1994 Cynthia Hutton was conductor.
- 1994–1997 Thomas Caneva, Assistant Director of Bands at the University of Colorado, was conductor.
- 1998–2000 Nathaniel Johnson was conductor.
- 2000–2006 Brian Hopwood was conductor.
- 2006–2009 Randall Coleman was conductor.
- 2009–2011 Zina Richardson was conductor and music director of the Boulder Concert Band.
- 2011–2013 Dana Biggs, Assistant Director of Bands at the University of Colorado, was conductor and music director.
- 2013–2014 Jeffrey Miller was conductor and music director.
- 2014 Matthew Arau and William Kinne co-conducted the summer season
- 2014–2015 William Kinne was conductor and music director.
- 2015–2016 Peter Lillpopp was conductor and music director.
- 2016–2017 Rafael Antonio Rodriguez was conductor and music director.
- 2017–2019 Silas Nathaniel Huff was conductor and music director.
- 2019–2023 Dr. Kenneth Singleton, retired Director of Bands at the University of Northern Colorado, was conductor and music director.
- 2023–Present Jon Borodach is conductor and music director.


